Overview

The Active Vision ACC-P19N-H4D is a versatile indoor/outdoor camera that can be used in a variety of CCTV applications and offers outstanding quality. The advanced lens system uses a revolutionary through-hole technology which allows the lens to pass through the lens cover. Eliminating IR glare for unmatched night time viewing and is designed for 24-hour surveillance applications. The ACC-P19N can be top or bottom mounted and has a weatherproof metal case with a sun/rain shield.

Installation and Connections

1. Mount the camera securely with the proper mounting hardware. The mounting hardware will vary based on the mounting surface, mounting bracket and location.
2. Connect the video BNC connector to a 75 ohm coaxial cable.
3. Connect the 2.1mm power plug to a 12V DC regulated power supply.
4. Adjust the camera viewing angle.

Caution: For eye safety do not stare into the IR light beam or any LED at close range.
